ORDINANCE NO. SP-**1532**, S-2005

AN ORDINANCE EXEMPTING INDIGENT FIRE VICTIMS FROM PAYMENT OF FIRE VICTIMS CERTIFICATION EVEN WITHOUT PAYING THE FIFTY PESOS (P50.00) FEE.

WHEREAS, the City government is at present collecting fees to our unfortunate indigent constituents who are victims of fire amounting to Fifty Pesos (P50.00) by the Bureau of Fire Protection before issuing a Fire Victims Certification;

WHEREAS, considering that said incident had already caused great inconvenience to the victims of fire brought about by devastation and destruction of lives and properties, thus, it is necessary for the local government to lessen and ease the burden they are experiencing by granting exemption from payment of the aforementioned certification fee;

WHEREAS, the Social Services Development Department (SSDD) will duly certify the indigent victims of fire in order to avail of the said exemption.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Exemption from payment of Fire Victims Certification Fee is hereby granted to indigent victims of fire amounting to Fifty Pesos (P50.00). Provided, that, a certification shall be secured from the Social Services Development Department that the victims are indigents.


SECTION 2. Any ordinance, executive issuances or part/s thereof which is contrary to this Ordinance is hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


