ORDINANCE NO. SP- **1533**, S-2005

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING AN ADDITIONAL ONE PESO (P1.00) TO ADMISSION FEES IN ALL CINEMAS IN QUEZON CITY, FROM DECEMBER 1 TO 31, 2005, THE PROCEEDS THEREOF TO BE DONATED TO THE QUEZON CITY RED CROSS IN CONNECTION WITH ITS COMMUNITY-BASED DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, Quezon City Red Cross is focusing on community-based projects designed to improve the capabilities of vulnerable barangays to cope with disaster situations and basic health problems through series of Red Cross initiated skills training;

WHEREAS, they also wanted to improve their facilities in blood transfusion and conducting a city-wide campaign on voluntary blood donation in order to meet the spiraling needs of blood of our countless indigent patients whose recovery is retardate due to unavailability of blood;

WHEREAS, this program will only be materialized if they have sufficient resources to support the project;

WHEREAS, to show the support of the Quezon City government, it intends to increase by One Pesos (P1.00) the admission fees in cinemas in the City, the proceeds thereof to be donated to Quezon City Red Cross.

WHEREAS, Section 36 of the Local Government Code provides that, "a local government unit, may, through its local chief executive and with the concurrence of the sanggunian concerned, provide assistance, financial or otherwise, to such people's and non-governmental organizations for economic, socially-oriented, environmental, or cultural projects to be implemented within its territorial jurisdiction."
