AN ORDINANCE DECLARING ALL DAY CARE CENTERS IN QUEZON CITY AS SCHOOLS INCLUSIVE OF CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS.

WHEREAS, it is the declared policy of the State to promote the general welfare and well-being of the Filipino child, insure his access to quality education, and provide equal benefits and opportunities to the disabled;

WHEREAS, the development and learning intervention for the physically, emotionally, or mentally impaired children are best implemented within the normal learning context where they regularly socialize and integrate with those who are otherwise considered as normal children.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:
