ORDINANCE NO. SP- 1544, S-2005

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING OWNERS/OPERATORS OF TERMINALS OF PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLES WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF QUEZON CITY TO SECURE SPECIAL PERMIT FROM THE CITY GOVERNMENT THROUGH THE CITY COUNCIL IN THE CONDUCT OF THEIR OPERATIONS.

WHEREAS, it is noted that many terminals of public utility vehicles in Quezon City lack public comfort and convenience, such as comfort rooms and/or comfortable waiting sections;

WHEREAS, as per provisions of Section 17 of the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlungsod is empowered to enact ordinances to ensure the efficient and effective delivery of the basic services and facilities that include terminals of public utility vehicles;

WHEREAS, the issuance of Special Permit from the City government through the City Council shall be instrumental to ensure that terminals of public utility vehicles will be more conducive for transporting passengers and comfortable to the riding public.
