ORDINANCE NO. SP. <u>1555</u>, s-2005 (PO2004-47)

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING STUDENT DRIVERS AND DRIVER INSTRUCTORS OF DRIVING SCHOOLS FROM DRIVING AND PASSING THROUGH BUSY MAJOR THOROUGHFARES, ROADS AND CITY STREETS WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF QUEZON CITY DURING RUSH OR PEAK HOURS.

WHEREAS, it appears to be the practice of many driving schools to allow their student drivers in the company of their driving instructors and pass through major thoroughfares, roads and city streets in Quezon City even during rush or peak hours;

WHEREAS, the conduct of driving lessons of student drivers by passing through said busy major thoroughfares, roads and city streets during peak or rush hours, slows down the free flow of vehicular traffic and add up to the chaotic traffic conditions in said thoroughfares, roads, and city streets, and further increase the possibility of accident which may result in loss of life and damage to property;

WHEREAS, there is a need to prohibit or regulate the use of busy major thoroughfares, roads and city streets by student drivers in order to minimize the possibility of accident.
