AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE (EA) TO ALL EMPLOYEES OF QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT PURSUANT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 120 ISSUED BY HER EXCELLENCY, PRESIDENT GLORIA MACAPAGAL ARROYO.

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2005, Her Excellency, President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo issued Executive Order No. 120 which authorizes the grant of Educational Assistance in the maximum amount of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) as a one-time-financial assistance to government personnel for FY 2005 in recognition of their contributions in providing quality service despite the government's austerity measures and to help them cope with the rising cost of education;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the said Executive Order, the grant of Educational Assistance to personnel of the local government units shall be subject to the passage of an appropriate Sanggunian Resolution/Ordinance for the purpose, subject to the Personal Services (PS) limitation under Sec. 325 (a) of R.A. 7160 (Local Government Code of 1991);

WHEREAS, the grant of Educational Assistance shall not exceed One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) pursuant to Executive Order No. 120;

WHEREAS, the Educational Assistance is just in time for school year 2005-2006 is about to start.
