ORDINANCE NO. SP- **1566**, S-2005  
(PO2005-92)

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING ALL SPORTS ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF QUEZON CITY WHETHER PRIVATE OR GOVERNMENT.**

FERRER, JR., WINSTON "Winnie" T. CASTELO, VOLTAIRE GODOFREDO L. LIBAN III, ALLAN BUTCH T. FRANCISCO, WENCEROM BENEDICT C. LAGUMBAY, DANTE M. DE GUZMAN and BAYANI V. HIPOL.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City government to promote physical education, encourage and sustain the development of sports in the city to foster physical fitness, self-discipline, team work and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry through a unified massive sports promotion and development program;

WHEREAS, "SPORTS" is one activity for the youth that should be given due attention since it has been an effective alternative in the city's campaign to counter drug addiction;

WHEREAS, there were on-going sports activities in our city that had become business in nature rather than promoting the true objective of these sports activities.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. All sports activities held in this City whether private or government should not be used as a fund-raising and the same should be coordinated with proper committee.

SECTION 2. All sports activities should be properly coordinated with the barangay nearest to its venue and its coordinator/organizer should secure clearance from the concerned Barangay Chairman.

SECTION 3. Any sports organizer/coordinator found violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be penalized for not less than Three Thousand Pesos (P3,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than thirty (30) days, or both upon the discretion of the court.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect after fifteen (15) days following the completion of its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
