ORDINANCE NO. SP- 1625, S-2005
(PO2005-261)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5 OF ORDINANCE NO. SP-1530, S-2005 "MANDATING RESIDENTS, OWNERS AND OPERATORS OF INSTITUTIONS AND ESTABLISHMENTS TO CLEAN THEIR OWN SURROUNDINGS INCLUDING CANALS, STREETS OR ROADS IN THEIR IMMEDIATE PREMISES", AUTHORIZING THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND WASTE MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT (EPWMD) TO UNDERTAKE THE IMPLEMENTATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF THIS ORDINANCE TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE THEREOF.

Introduced by Councilors JORGE B. BANAL, JR., WINSTON "Winnie" T. CASTELO, ANTONIO E. INTON, JR., JANET M. MALAYA and RESTITUTO B. MALAÑGEN.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. SP-1530, S-2005, was passed by the City Council mandating residents, owners and operators of institutions and establishments to clean their own surroundings including canals, streets or roads in their immediate premises to make Quezon City a cleaner and healthier place to live in, and providing penalties for violation thereof;

WHEREAS, Section 2.2 of Ordinance No. SP-982, S-2000, as amended by SP-1054, S-2001, provides that the Environmental Protection and Waste Management Department shall "enforce laws, regulations, and policies pertaining to environmental management and pollution control";

WHEREAS, Section 2.4 of the same Ordinance further provides that the Environmental Protection and Waste Management Department shall "formulate civic-consciousness programs geared towards environmental sanitation, e.g., cleanliness, proper waste disposal and waste recycling for barangays to be implemented in coordination with the barangays x x x".
