ORDINANCE NO. SP-1645 S-2006 (PO2006-17)

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE DEADLINE FOR THE PAYMENT OF BUSINESS TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES FOR 2006 BY THE TAXPAYERS FROM JANUARY 20, 2006 TO JANUARY 31, 2006, WITHOUT SURCHARGES OR PENALTIES, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE ORDINANCE NO. SP-1639, S-2006, AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE PERIOD FOR PAYMENT OF BUSINESS TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES FROM JANUARY 20, 2006 TO JANUARY 31, 2006.

## Introduced by Councilors ANTONIO E. INTON, JR. and RESTITUTO B. MALAÑGEN.

WHEREAS, there were taxpayers who paid their business taxes, fees and charges who were not credited with the 10% discount pursuant to Ordinance SP-1086, S-2001, because Ordinance No. SP-1639, S-2006, extending the period for the payment of such taxes did not so provide;

WHEREAS, in fairness to the said taxpayers, and as by way of incentives to pay their taxes and settle their tax obligation to the City government promptly and within the prescribed time, there is a need to amend Ordinance No. SP-1639, S-2006.

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. SP-1639, S-2006, is hereby amended, to read as follows:

Section 1. Coverage – All annual and quarterly business taxes, fees and charges due and payable to the Quezon City government for 2006 which is due to be paid on or before January 20, 2006, can be paid not later than January 31, 2006 without any penalty, surcharges or interest.

Taxpayers who have paid business taxes, fees and charges during the extended period from January 20, 2006 to January 31, 2006, are entitled to a 10% discount of such taxes, fees and charges, pursuant to Ordinance No. SP-1086, S-2001.
