ORDINANCE NO. SP-1661, 8-2006 (PO2006-28)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 3, 4(a) AND 6 OF ORDINANCE NO. SP-1631, S-2005 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SELLING ENDANGERED/EXOTIC ANIMALS IN MALLS AND OTHER ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF QUEZON CITY," SO AS TO INCLUDE THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE (DA) AS ONE OF THE IMPLEMENTING AGENCIES, AND AUTHORIZING THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ANDWASTE MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT (EPWMD) TO ISSUE AN ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE OR PERMIT TO MALL AND OTHER ESTABLISHMENTS WHICH HAVE BEEN CLEARED AND FOUND DURING THE INSPECTION NOT SELLING ENDANGERED/EXOTIC ANIMALS.
