ORDINANCE NO. SP- 1664, 8-2006 (PO2006-29)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TITLE OF ORDINANCE NO. 8-2005, SP-1633. "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SELLING OF ENDANGERED/EXOTIC ANIMALS RESTAURANTS WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF SO AS TO INCLUDE "AND QUEZON CITY", ESTABLISHMENTS", SECTION 3, 4 (A) AND 6 THEREOF, SO AS TO INCLUDE THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE (DA) ONE OF THE IMPLEMENTING AGENCIES, AUTHORIZING THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND WASTE MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT (EPWMD) TO ISSUE AN ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE OR PERMIT RESTAURANTS AND SIMILAR ESTABLISHMENTS WHICH HAVE BEEN CLEARED AND FOUND DURING THE INSPECTION NOT SELLING ENDANGERED/EXOTIC ANIMALS AS FOOD TO ITS CLIENTELE.
