AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL LITIGATION SUPPORT FUND TO PROVIDE ALLOWANCE FOR BARANGAY SECURITY DEVELOPMENT OFFICERS (BSDOs) WHO ATTEND COURT HEARINGS AS PART OF THE PROSECUTION OR WITNESS IN THE PROSECUTION OF SUSPECTED CRIMINALS THAT WOULD ULTIMATELY CONTRIBUTE IN ATTAINING THE END OF JUSTICE AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY FUNDS FOR ITS EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City government to enact policies that would ensure the promotion of justice and the maintenance of peace and order, in every community;

WHEREAS, as peace officers in our community, our BSDO members are always first to respond to a crime scene, thus making them vital witness in prosecuting suspected criminals;

WHEREAS, most of our BSDOs are just receiving meager allowance from our Barangays such that they can hardly afford to attend court hearings due to lack of financial means which usually leads to the weakening of the prosecution and eventual dismissal of complaint against suspected criminals.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. There is hereby establish a Special Litigation Support Fund to provide allowance for BSDO members who attend court hearings as part of the prosecution or witness.
