ORDINANCE NO. SP-1697, S-2006

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY GOVERNMENT TO UNDERTAKE EXPROPRIATION PROCEEDINGS OVER A PARCEL OF LAND SITUATED AT NO. 42 KAPILIGAN STREET, BARANGAY DOÑA IMELDA, QUEZON CITY, CONSISTING OF THIRTY (30) SQUARE METERS IN LENGTH AND ONE (1) METER IN WIDTH, TO BE EXCLUSIVELY USED AS A PERMANENT "ACCESS ROAD" BY THE RESIDENTS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Section 19, of the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers the Local Government Unit, through its Chief Executive and acting pursuant to an Ordinance, to exercise the power of eminent domain for public use, or purpose, or welfare for the benefits of the poor and the landless, upon payment of just compensation;

WHEREAS, the residents of the said barangay has been encountering numerous problems since the closing of the said parcel of land because it is the only accessible way of going to the main street of Kapiligan;

WHEREAS, the subject parcel of land has the total land area of 600.21 square meters which is owned by Lim Kee Tee.
