WHEREAS, the vector mosquitoes of Dengue are predominantly urban dwellers which are common in highly urbanized area and with high population density like Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the increasing population is complemented by poor environmental sanitation which favors breeding sites for mosquitoes;

WHEREAS, Dengue is fatal disease caused by dengue virus that is transmitted by Aedes mosquito;

WHEREAS, the carrier, Aedes Aegypti/Albopictus is a day-biting mosquito that breeds in clear stagnant water usually collected in open drums, clogged water spout, flower vases, old tires, makeshift roofs (trapal);

WHEREAS, the best intervention to prevent Dengue is to maintain a clean environment with citizenry's participation.
