ORDNANCE NO. SP- 1705 S-2006
(PO2006-99)

AN ORDNANCE RESTRICTING VEHICLES WITH 5-TON CAPACITY OR MORE FROM USING THE ST. FRANCIS VILLAGE BRIDGE LOCATED IN BARANGAY SAN BARTOLOME, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, under Section 458 (5) (V) of the Local Government Code of 1991 (RA 7160) the Sangguniang Panlungsod is empowered to:

"Regulate the use of streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, bridges, parks and x x x";

"Regulate traffic on all streets and bridges; prohibiting encroachment or obstacles thereon and, when necessary in the interest of public welfare, authorize the removal of encroachments and illegal constructions in public places,"

WHEREAS, in the interest of public welfare, the City government has been clothed with the power to regulate the use of bridges and impose proper and reasonable restraint upon their use in order to foster the common good;

WHEREAS, the restriction of the use of St. Francis Village bridge in Barangay San Bartolome by vehicles with 5-ton capacity or more has been recommended by the Quezon City Engineer's Office.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDANED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The use of St. Francis Village bridge in Barangay San Bartolome is hereby regulated as follows:


- 1.1 Light vehicles shall be allowed to use the bridge.
- 1.2 All vehicles with 5-ton capacity or more shall be restricted to use the bridge.

SECTION 2. Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall be fined in accordance with existing traffic code.
