AN ORDINANCE GRANTING AMNESTY TO DELINQUENT TRAFFIC VIOLATORS IN QUEZON CITY APPREHENDED FOR THE MONTHS OF OCTOBER TO DECEMBER 2005 BY CONDONING THE FIVE PERCENT (5%) PENALTY PER DAY.
