AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P300,000.00) OR SO MUCH THEREOF TO BE ALLOCATED ANNUALLY FOR THE SPONSORSHIP BY QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT OF AN AWARD FOR THE MOST GENDER SENSITIVE MOVIE IN THE METRO MANILA FILM FESTIVAL AND OTHER REPUTABLE FILM COMPETITION AND/OR EXHIBITION, THE AMOUNT TO BE TAKEN FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY TREASURY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Quezon City has adopted Resolution No. SP-3196, S-2005, as amended by SP-3431, S-2006, authorizing the Honorable City Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to allocate the amount of Three Hundred Thousand Pesos (P300,000.00) annually from any funds appropriated under the Office of the City Mayor against which said amount may be lawfully charged for the sponsorship by the Quezon City government of an award for the Most Gender Sensitive Movie in the Metro Manila Film Festival and other reputable film competition and/or exhibition;

WHEREAS, the City government through the Gender and Development Resource and Coordinating Office has been continuously and successfully sponsoring the said awards for the last four years and it gained appreciation from the sectors who are advocating and promoting for gender sensitivity and responsible media industry;
