AN ORDINANCE DECLARING SAN ISIDRO STREET FROM VISAYAN AVENUE TO LUZON AVENUE, BARANGAY SAN ISIDRO GALAS AND BARANGAY STO. NIÑO, QUEZON CITY, AS ONE WAY STREET.
