WHEREAS, recognizing that the Philippine government has declared its full support for the international community's campaign to fight trafficking in persons, especially women and children;

WHEREAS, realizing that persons especially women and children need to be afforded protection against violence and exploitation, and concrete measures should be taken to eliminate trafficking of these vulnerable sectors of the community;

WHEREAS, acknowledging that the Anti-Trafficking in Persons Act of 2003, which serves as the national framework to address trafficking issues and concerns, has been signed into law on 26 May 2003;
