ORDINANCE NO. SP-**1806**S-2007  
(PO2007-18)

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL CINEMA OWNERS AND OPERATORS IN QUEZON CITY TO INCREASE THE PRICE OF THEIR ADMISSION TICKETS BY ONE PESO (P1.00) COVERING THE ENTIRE PERIOD OF JANUARY 2008, TO SUPPORT THE PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE BOY SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES, QUEZON CITY CHAPTER.
