AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE BUSINESS REGULATION AND AREA VIABILITY BETWEEN AUTOGAS/LPG DISPENSING STATIONS IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, Section 15 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as "The Local Government Code of 1991", provides for the General Welfare Clause:

"Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, x x x, promote health and safety, x x x, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, x x x, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants."
