AN ORDINANCE RENAMING MANILA GRAVEL PIT ROAD, BARANGAY PAYATAS, DISRICT II, QUEZON CITY TO "PAYATAS ROAD".

WHFREAS, streets, avenues, boulevards, parks, playgrounds, historical spots and other places are so named as to signify and perpetuate the greatness and nobility of certain personage of note, or the significance of certain event;

WHEREAS, Section 13, paragraph b (2) of the Local Government Code of 1991 provide that:

"The Sangguniang of highly urbanized cities and component cities whose charters prohibited their votes from voting for provincial elective officials, herein after referred to this Code as independent component cities, may, in consultation with the Philippine Historical Commission, change the name of the following within its territorial jurisdiction.
