**AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL CINEMA OWNERS AND OPERATORS IN QUEZON CITY TO INCREASE THE PRICE OF THEIR ADMISSION FEES BY ONE PESO (P1.00) COVERING THE PERIOD OF JUNE 1 TO 30, 2009, THE PROCEEDS THEREOF SHALL BE DONATED TO YOUNG MEN'S CHRISTIAN ASSOCIATION (YMCA), QUEZON CITY CHAPTER, TO SUPPORT ITS PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES FOR QUEZON CITY STUDENTS AND PUPILS, BOTH HIGH SCHOOLS AND ELEMENTARY, RESPECTIVELY.**
