AN ORDINANCE RECLASSIFYING AND/OR REZONING ONE (1) LOT DEEP BOTH SIDES OF KATIPUNAN AVENUE EXTENDING FROM THEBOUNDARY OFST. **IGNATIUS** VILLAGE SUBDIVISION TO WHITEPLAINS AVENUE, BARANGAY WHITE PLAINS, DISTRICT III, QUEZON CITY, FROM LOW-DENSITY RESIDENTIAL ZONE (R-1) TO SPECIAL DEVELOPMENT ZONE AND AMENDING FOR THAT PURPOSE SECTION 2, ARTICLE IV. QUEZON CITY ORDINANCE NO. SP-918, S-2000, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE QUEZON CITY COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED.
