ORDINANCE NO. SP-1916 S-2009

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING BAYAN, VILLEGAS, MOORE, BALER, LOWER MILLER AND REST HAVEN STREETS OF BARANGAY BUNGAD AS "NO PARKING ON BOTH SIDES" OR "TOW AWAY ZONE" FROM 6:00 AM TO 9:00 PM AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Quezon City pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Code, has the power to enact laws and ordinances as maybe necessary to discharge the responsibilities conferred upon it by law or ordinance and to promote the general welfare of the inhabitants;

WHEREAS, since Bayan, Villegas, Moore, Baler, Lower Miller and Rest Haven Streets are under the jurisdiction of Barangay Bungad, declared as busy road considering the number of vehicles passing through it from EDSA to West Avenue, from West Avenue to Roosevelt Avenue vice versa and other streets of the Barangay;

WHEREAS, there is an imperative need to lessen if not to eradicate and/or remove the cause of trip delays, traffic accidents and fuel/energy wastage;

WHEREAS, motorists often fail to observe road courtesy and discipline, rules and regulations while operating motor vehicles, creating traffic accidents, prone incidents and near collision occurrences;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Quezon City deems it very wise to provide ways and means to maximize the safe use of roads and streets of the City.

NOW THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as "DECLARING BAYAN, VILLEGAS, MOORE, BALER, LOWER MILLER AND REST HAVEN STREETS OF BARANGAY BUNGAD AS "NO PARKING ON BOTH SIDES" OR "TOW AWAY ZONE" FROM 6:00 AM TO 9:00 PM AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF."

SECTION 2. "PARKING OR PARKED" - shall mean that a motor vehicle is "parked" or "parking" if it has been brought to a stop and remains inactive in that place or close thereto for a reasonable period of time. A motor vehicle which properly discharge a passenger or to take in passenger, or load or unload a small quantity of freight shall not be considered "parked" provided, the motor vehicle should not cause delay, under the provision of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. "NO PARKING AREA" OR "TOW AWAY ZONE" - "Tow-Away Zone" - means a no parking zone from which motor vehicles may be towed away. "No Parking-Area" means that portion of the street that has been designated with a red-painted curb indicating that parking of vehicles is prohibited.

SECTION 4. Bayan, Villegas, Moore, Baler, Lower Miller and Rest Haven Streets of Barangay Bungad are hereby declared as no parking zone and tow-away zone from EDSA to West Avenue from West Avenue to Roosevelt Avenue or vice versa.

SECTION 5. PENALTIES – Any person or persons found violating the provision of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of Three Hundred Pesos (P300.00).

SECTION 6. The Department of Public Order and Safety of this City and Philippine National Police of Quezon City Station personnel shall insure the strict implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7. All Ordinance/s contrary to or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and annulled.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY – This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
