ORDINANCE NO. SP-1946 S-2009

AN ORDINANCE ENJOINING ALL BARANGAYS IN QUEZON CITY TO REGISTER PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES RESIDING WITHIN THEIR TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION TO AVAIL OF THE PRIVILEGES AND INCENTIVES ACCORDED TO THEM UNDER REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9442 AMENDING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7277, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE MAGNA CARTA FOR DISABLED PERSONS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, it is enshrined in the 1987 Philippine Constitution particularly in Article XIII, Social Justice and Human Rights, Section 11 thereof, that;
