AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A ONE PESO (P1.00) INCREASE TO ADMISSION FEES IN ALL CINEMAS IN QUEZON CITY COVERING THE PERIOD FROM NOVEMBER 1-30, 2009, THE PROCEEDS THEREOF TO BE DONATED TO THE BOY SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES, QUEZON CITY COUNCIL, TO SUPPORT ITS NUMEROUS PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES.
