ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2025, S-2010

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A ONE PESO (P1.00) INCREASE TO ADMISSION FEES IN ALL CINEMAS IN QUEZON CITY COVERING THE PERIOD FROM AUGUST 1 TO 31, 2010, THE PROCEEDS THEREOF TO BE DONATED TO THE BOY SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES, QUEZON CITY COUNCIL, TO SUPPORT ITS NUMEROUS PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES.
