ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2242, S-2013

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE BALON-BATO HEALTH CENTER LOCATED WITHIN THE TEACHERS' BLISS, BARANGAY BALON-BATO, THIS CITY, IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR THE HEALTH AND MEDICAL NEEDS NOT ONLY THE RESIDENTS OF BARANGAY BALON-BATO, BUT ALSO THOSE OF ADJACENT BARANGAY UNANG SIGAW, APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY FUNDS THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Article 2, Section 15 of the 1987 Constitution provides that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, it is likewise the policy of the Quezon City Government to adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to make essential health and other social services available to all the people at a fordable cost;

WHEREAS, it is within the conferred powers of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, as provided for in Section 17 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as The Local Government Code of 1991, to exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and facilities;

WHEREAS, in pursuance of the above mandate, the City Government seeks to establish a primary Health facility in Barangay Balon-bato in order to effectively respond to the needs of its increasing population as well as the residents of contiguous Barangay Unang Sigaw.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY
IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

Section 1. There is hereby established a Barangay Balon-Bato Health Center Located at Teachers' Bliss compound, Barangay Balon-bato, this City, in order to provide for the health and medical needs not only the residents of Barangay Balon-Bato, but also those of adjacent Barangay Unang Sigaw.

Section 2. Funding - The funding for the establishment operation, and personnel complement of the Balon-Bato Health Center shall initially be taken from the Office of the City Mayor. Thereafter, the same shall be included in the Annual Appropriations of the City Health Department through the recommendation of the City Health Officer.




Section 3. The City Health Department is mandated to establish the necessary medical and non-medical staff requirements of the said health Center.


Section 4. Separability Clause - If for any reason, any provision, section or part of this Ordinance is declared not valid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections or parts thereof which shall remain or continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effectivity. - This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
