ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2524, S-2016

AN ORDINANCE ACCREDITING THE ONE THOUSAND EIGHTY ONE (1,081) NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS (NGOs) AND PEOPLE'S ORGANIZATIONS (POs), PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991 AND ITS IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS, IN RELATION TO DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DILG) MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2016-97.

WHEREAS, Section 34 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", provides that the Local Government Units shall promote the establishment and operations of non-governmental organizations (NGOs) and people's organizations (POs) to become partners in the pursuit of local economy;

WHEREAS, Article 64 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the local Sanggunian concerned shall accredit non-governmental and people's organizations subject to the criteria and procedures provided therein for membership in the local special bodies;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991, its Implementing Rules and Regulations, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2016-97 and Ordinance No. SP-23, S-92, as supplemented by Ordinance No. SP-1494, S-2005 and Ordinance No. SP-1942, S-2009, a call for Accreditation was made by the Quezon City Government through the City's Vice Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte;

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. SP-23, S-92, the NGO and PO Accreditation Committee was created to process applications for accreditation of NGOs and POs;

WHEREAS, these One Thousand Eighty One (1,081) NGOs and POs applied for accreditation with the Quezon City Council, through the Community Relations Office;

WHEREAS, these applications of the said organizations were processed and evaluated by the NGO and PO Accreditation Committee and favorably recommended their accreditation to the Quezon City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY
IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. There is hereby accredited the One Thousand Eighty One (1,081) organizations, pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991, its Implementing Rules and Regulations and DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2016-97.

SECTION 2. The herein accredited organizations shall inform, within thirty (30) days, the Quezon City Council, through the Office of the City Secretary, copy furnished the Community Relations Office, of any major changes in their organizations, particularly with respect to their officers and office addresses.

SECTION 3. The Quezon City Government, through the Office of the City Secretary and in coordination with the Community Relations Office, shall prepare and issue Certificates of Accreditation to the herein accredited organizations, duly signed by the City Mayor, the City Vice Mayor and the Chairman of the NGO and PO Accreditation Committee and attested by the City Secretary.





SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.




