WHEREAS, a large number of taxpayers are expected to pay business tax for calendar year 2017 within the reglementary period provided by law until 20 January 2017 which the Office of the City Treasurer may not be able to accommodate owing to limitations of time and human resources;

WHEREAS, Section 167 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that all local taxes, fees and charges shall be paid within the first twenty(20) days of January or of each subsequent quarter but the Sangguniang Panlungsod may, for a justifiable reason or cause, extend the same without surcharges for a period not exceeding six (6) months;
