ORDINANCE NO. SP- **2557**, S-2016

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT TO SET ASIDE AT LEAST ONE PERCENT (1%) OF ITS GENERAL FUND AND ALLOCATE THE SAME FOR PROGRAMS, PROJECTS, AND ACTIVITIES OF PERSONS WITH DISABILITY (PWD) BEGINNING YEAR 2017.

There shall be priority for the needs of the underprivileged, sick, elderly, disabled, women, and children;
