AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MULTI-PURPOSE EVACUATION CENTERS IN EVERY DISTRICT OF QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, according to a study made in 2009 by the Economy and Environment Program for Southeast Asia (EEPSEA), Metro Manila is the seventh most vulnerable in Southeast Asia in terms of its vulnerability to multiple climate hazards such as cyclones, landslides, earthquakes, floods and droughts;

WHEREAS, there is a necessity to construct Multi-Purpose Evacuation Centers in every district of Quezon City to enhance disaster preparedness in the community;

WHEREAS, various measures were approved by the Quezon City Council related to the identification and construction of evacuation centers, to wit:

- a. Resolution No. SP-3925, S-2007, entitled "A Resolution urging the 142 Barangays in Quezon City to identify and designate an evacuation area in their respective barangays to be utilized in the occurrence of disasters or natural calamities; "
