ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2602, S-2017

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION NUMBER 1, GENERAL FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017 IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE BILLION FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY NINE MILLION ONE HUNDRED THIRTY SIX THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY EIGHT PESOS (PHP5,589,136,178.00) TO FUND VARIOUS MAINTENANCE AND OTHER OPERATING EXPENSES AND PROPERTY, PLANT AND EQUIPMENT EXPENDITURES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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WHEREAS, on 20 December 2016, Ordinance No. SP-2552, Series of 2016 was approved providing for the amount of Seventeen Billion Seven Hundred Twenty Million Pesos (P17,720,000,000.00) to cover for various expenditures to support the operations, programs, projects and activities of the City Government;

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WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the Finance Committee, duly certified by the Local Treasurer, funds are actually available, there is a need to appropriate the amount of Five Billion Five Hundred Eighty Nine Million One Hundred Thirty Six Thousand One Hundred Seventy Eight Pesos (Php5,589,136,178.00) to fund various maintenance and other operating expenses and property, plant and equipment expenditures;

WHEREAS, the Supplemental Appropriation is necessary to ensure sustainability and completion of programs, activities and infrastructure construction projects of the City Government.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION – The amount of Five Billion Five Hundred Eighty Nine Million One Hundred Thirty Six Thousand One Hundred Seventy Eight Pesos (Php5,589,136,178.00) is hereby declared as Supplemental Appropriation Number 1, General Fund for Fiscal Year 2017 to be defrayed for the following purposes:






