WHEREAS, the State adopts an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavour to make essential goods, health and other social services available to all the people at affordable cost, and emphasizes on the need to prioritize the needs of the children, among others;

WHEREAS, the Responsible Parenthood and Reproductive Health Act of 2013 (R.A. No. 10354), otherwise known as the RPRH Law, defines "adolescents" as young people between the ages of 10 and 19 who are in transition from childhood to adulthood.
