AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE NEW SENIOR CITIZENS IDENTIFICATION CARDS TO BE ISSUED BY THE OFFICE FOR SENIOR CITIZENS AFFAIRS OF QUEZON CITY (OSCA) TO RESIDENT SENIOR CITIZENS OF QUEZON CITY STARTING YEAR 2018 AND PROVIDING FOR THE GUIDELINES ON ITS ISSUANCE AND REPLACEMENT OF OLD SENIOR CITIZEN I.D. CARDS.
