*WHEREAS, propriety dictates that social behavior must be acceptable, morally correct and proper;*

*WHEREAS, naked persons in public places erodes decency, exacerbates disorder, and setting a bad example to children;*

*WHEREAS, in the exercise of its police power, the City Council, as the legislative body, may enact ordinances to promote decency, public morals, security, public safety, and the general welfare of the people;*
