WHEREAS, according to the Metro Manila Accident Reporting and Analysis System (MMARAS) of the Metro Manila Development Authority (MMDA), Quezon City has consistently had the highest number of road crashes and road crash fatalities and injuries in Metro Manila from 2010 to 2016;

WHEREAS, in 2016 alone, Quezon City accounted for 33,717 road crashes with 116 fatalities, contributing about 27% to the total number of fatal road crashes in Metro Manila as recorded by the MMDA;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Quezon City has adopted several ordinances designed to promote road safety;
