AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. SP-1623, S-2005, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE CREATING A BARANGAY COUNCIL FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN (BCPC) IN EVERY BARANGAY IN QUEZON CITY".

WHEREAS, Section 13, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that, "The State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being";

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City government that the rights of the children for survival, protection, participation and development of their potentials must be given priority;

WHEREAS, the City government, in its effort to address the needs of the most vulnerable sector of our society, passed Ordinance No. SP-1623, S-2005 creating a Council for the Protection of Children in every barangay;

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) issued Memorandum Circular No. (MC) 2002-121 or the Revised Guidelines on the Organization and Strengthening of the Local Councils for the Protection of Children (LCPC) incorporating thereat Early Childhood Care and Development (ECCD) Coordinating Committees at the Provincial, City, Municipal and Barangay Levels; †
