WHEREAS, one of the most important 'best practices' that has been incorporated into the National Incident Command System (NIMS) is the Incident Command System (ICS), a standard, on-scene, all-hazards incident management system already in use by firefighters, hazardous materials teams, rescuers and emergency medical teams. The ICS has been established by the NIMS as the standardized incident organizational structure for the management of all incidents;

WHEREAS, the National Disaster Risk Reduction And Management Council (NDRRMC) issued Memorandum Circular No. 4, S-2012, an implementing guidelines on the use of Incident Command System (ICS) as an On-Scene Disaster Response and Management Mechanism under the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management System (PDDRMS);
