WHEREAS, Section 13, paragraph (b) sub-paragraph (3) of the Local Government Code of 1991, authorizes the Sangguniang Panlungsod of highly urbanized cities, in consultation with the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP), to change the name of public elementary, secondary, and vocational or technical schools, community colleges, and non-chartered colleges;

WHEREAS, the NOH School for Crippled Children adopted a Resolution regarding the proposed renaming of the school from National Orthopedic Hospital (NOH) School for Crippled Children to POC-School for Differently Abled Learners.
