ORDINANCE NO. SP- **2725**, S-2018

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A ONE PESO (P1.00) INCREASE ON THE ADMISSION FEES IN ALL CINEMAS IN QUEZON CITY COVERING THE MONTH OF OCTOBER 2018, THE PROCEEDS THEREOF TO BE DONATED TO THE BOY SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES, QUEZON CITY COUNCIL, TO SUPPORT ITS NUMEROUS PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES.
