WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the local Government Units are empowered to exercise powers which are essential for the promotion of the general welfare, to ensure and support the promotion of health and safety among its inhabitants and to preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, it has been observed that in thickly populated and depressed areas in Quezon City, there were some families who opted to place the coffin of their deceased loved ones outside their houses, specifically on the streets, due to lack of space or financial incapacity to defray the expenses of functial home services;
