ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2765 S-2018

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL MOTORCYCLE DRIVERS AND PASSENGERS TO IMMEDIATELY REMOVE THEIR SAFETY HELMETS, HEAD GEARS, FACE MASKS, AND/OR ANYTHING THAT WILL CONCEAL THEIR IDENTITY WHEN THEY ARE IN FULL STOP, WAITING, OR STAND-BY MODE ALONG ANY SUBDIVISION OR PUBLIC ROAD, STREET, ALLEY, SIDEWALK, EASEMENT, SHOULDER, OR ANY PORTION OF THE THOROUGHFARE OR HIGHWAY AND SUCH OTHER CRIME-PRONE AREAS OR HOTSPOTS IN QUEZON CITY, OR WHEN ENTERING ANY PRIVATE OR PUBLIC ESTABLISHMENT WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF QUEZON CITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.
