PROVIDING ORDINANCE COMPREHENSIVE SOCIALIZED HOUSING CODE OF 2018. Introduced by Councilors MARIVIC CO-PILAR AND ALEXIS R. HERRERA. Co-Introduced by Councilors Ranulfo Z. Ludovica, Gian Carlo G. Sotto, Raquel S. Malangen, Godofredo T. Liban II, Kate Abigael G. Coseteng, Ivy Xenia L. Lagman, Irene R. Belmonte, Ramon P. Medalla, Franz S. Pumaren and Alfredo S. Roxas.

WHEREAS, Quezon City is the largest city in Metro Manila, with a land area of more or less 161,125,800 sqm;

WHEREAS, Quezon City has a population of 2,936,116 with a growth rate of 1.17% according to the 2015 census of the Philippine Statistics Authority;

WHEREAS, the increase in economic activities and growing economic opportunities in Quezon City has led to a rapid urbanization and in-city migration, which in turn, led to the formation of slums and squatter settlements where the basic needs of citizens are not adequately met;

WHEREAS, as of 2017, an estimated 30% of Quezon City's population or 190,772 households are considered Informal Settler Families (ISF) with 5.2% or 9,920 living in danger areas;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7279 or the Urban Development and Housing Act mandates the State, through local government units, to develop and implement a comprehensive orban development and housing program; 🗼
