WHEREAS, Sec. 59 Par. (b) and (d) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates the secretary to the sanggunian concerned to post an approved ordinance or resolution in the bulletin board of the City Hall and in at least two (2) conspicuous places in the local government unit concerned, and in case of highly urbanized cities, in addition to said postings, to cause its publication in a local newspaper of general circulation;


WHEREAS, despite the foregoing statutory provisions, the general public, including the different/enforcing agencies of the government, appear to be unaware of many Ordinances/Resolutions enacted by the Quezon City Council such that there are laws which had become dead letters in the statute books due to non-implementation and/or enforcement;

WHEREAS, considering the strategic situation of the Barangay, it being the primary implementing unit of government policies operating at grassroots level, its facilities such as the Barangay Tanods, may be utilized in the dissemination and enforcement of City Ordinances/Resolutions, particularly those with penal provisions;


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to direct, as it does hereby direct, the City Secretary to furnish all Barangays of Quezon City, through the Barangay Operations Center, with list and/or copies of approved city ordinances/resolutions for dissemination, monitoring and enforcement in coordination with the government agencies concerned.
