RESOLUTION NO. SP-187, S-93

A RESOLUTION URGING THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD OF QUEZON CITY TO INCREASE THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE BEING GIVEN TO ALL ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS UNDER THE DIVISION OF CITY SCHOOLS, QUEZON CITY, FROM SIX HUNDRED PESOS (P600.00) TO ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) EACH.

WHEREAS, the members of the Quezon City Council are fully aware that the basic salary of all elementary and secondary public school teachers is not sufficient to support the members of their respective families;

WHEREAS, the present financial assistance being given to all elementary and secondary public school teachers stationed in or assigned to the city is not enough to cope with the present increasing prices of basic commodities;


WHEREAS, the Local School Board of Quezon City has sufficient funds to provide additional benefits to the aforementioned public school teachers which may be taken from its share of the proceeds of the special levy on real property and such other sources;

WHEREAS, the said School Board has the authority to appropriate said funds in accordance with existing rules and regulations;


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Local School Board of Quezon City to increase the financial assistance being given to all elementary and secondary public school teachers, permanent, new or substitute, or contractual, under the Division of City Schools, Quezon City, from Six Hundred Pesos (P600.00) to One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) each.
