A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE ISMAEL A. MATHAY, JR., TO AVAIL OF THE LEGAL SERVICES OF A PRIVATE PRACTITIONER IN THE PERSON OF FORMER JUSTICE MANUEL M. LAZARO IN THE CASE FILED AGAINST THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT REPRESENTED BY THE CITY MAYOR, BEFORE THE REGIONAL TRIAL COURT, SAME CITY, BY THE HAWKERS MANAGEMENT FOUNDATION, INC. AND Q.C. MANUFACTURING CORPORATION, IN CONNECTION WITH THE POSSESSION OF THE 2-HECTARE LOT PRESENTLY OCCUPIED BY THE PEOPLE'S PARK AT THE NORTH AVENUE, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the Honorable City Mayor prefers former Justice Manuel M. Lazaro, a private practitioner, to act as his Defense Counsel in the aforementioned civil case;

WHEREAS, the said civil case is now being heard by Branch 220, RTC, Quezon City, it has become imperative that the Honorable City Mayor be authorized to retain former Justice Manuel M. Lazaro as his Counsel in the said case as soon as possible;
