Resolution No. SP- 627, S-96

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE SEVENTEEN (17) FAMILIES WHO WERE RENDERED HOMELESS BY A FIRE AT UNANG HAKBANG/BAGONG BUHAY, GALAS, BARANGAY STO. NINO, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY, ON OCTOBER 6, 1996, IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) PER FAMILY OWNER AND ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) PER FAMILY RENTER/SHARER AND ALLOCATING THE SUM OF TWENTY TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P22,000.00) TO BE TAKEN FROM THE CALAMITY OR EMERGENCY FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS IN THE CITY TREASURY.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council is empowered under Section 458 (a), (1), (iv) of R.A. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, to "adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the City from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities and their return to productive livelihood following said events."

WHEREAS, on October 6, 1996, Unang Hakbang/Bagong Buhay, Galas, Barangay Sto. Nino, District IV, Quezon City, was hit by fire rendering homeless as per census by the Social Services Development Department (SSDD), seventeen (17) families categorized as follows:

Family Owners	Five	( 5)
Family Renters	Eleven	(11)
Family Sharers	One	( 1)
Total	Seventeen	(17)

WHEREAS, because of this unfortunate incident, our constituents, who are presently in makeshift dwellings can only hope for and pray for the early release of financial assistance from the City government.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to extend, as it does hereby extend, financial assistance to the seventeen (17) families who were rendered homeless by a fire at Unang Hakbang/Bagong Buhay, Galas, Barangay Sto. Nino, District IV, Quezon City, on October 6, 1996, in the amount of two thousand pesos (P2,000.00) per family owner and one thousand pesos (P1,000.00) per family renter/sharer and allocating the sum of twenty two thousand pesos (P22,000.00) to be taken from the calamity or emergency fund of the City government or from any available funds in the City Treasury.


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Social Services Development Department shall validate and authenticate the list of fire victims categorized into family owner, family renter and family sharer and to submit the same to the Office of the Mayor likewise making representation for the early release of the financial assistance to qualified recipients.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the Office of the City Mayor shall revalidate and confirm the list submitted by the Social Services Development Department which will be the basis for the preparation of the payroll and to approve the immediate release of funds allocated for the purpose.
