RESOLUTION NO. SP- 748, S-97

A RESOLUTION ALLOCATING THE AMOUNT OF FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (P50,000.00) TO DEFRAY THE COST OF RELIEF OPERATIONS FOR THE VICTIMS OF A FIRE THAT GUTTED THE HOUSES OF THIRTY-THREE (33) FAMILIES AT 96 ROTC HUNTERS CLUSTER 4, BARANGAY TATALON, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY, ON JULY 7, 1997, TO BE TAKEN FROM THE CALAMITY FUND UNDER THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF 1997.

Introduced by Councilors NANETTE CASTELO DAZA, JOSEPH PETER S. SISON, BAYANI V. HIPOL, ALFREDO A. FRANCISCO (Fred Montilla) and RAMON G. MATHAY.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council is empowered under Section 458 (a), (I), (iv) of R.A. 7160 otherwise as the Local Government Code of 1991, to adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the City from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities and their return to productive livelihood following said events;

WHEREAS, on July 7, 1997, 96 ROTC Hunters, Cluster 4, District IV, Quezon City, was hit by fire rendering homeless as per census by the Social Services Development Department (SSDD), thirty-three (33) families, categorized as follows;

Family Owners	Seventeen	17
Family Renters/Sharers	Sixteen	<u>16</u>
Total	Thirty-Three	33


WHEREAS, because of this unfortunate incident, our constituents, who are presently in makeshift dwellings, can only hope for and pray for the early release of financial assistance from the City government.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to allocate, as it does hereby allocate, the amount of Fifty Thousand Pesos (P50,000.00) to defray the cost of relief operations for the victims of a fire that gutted the houses of thirty-three (33) families on 96 ROTC Hunters Cluster 4, Barangay Tatalon, District IV, Quezon City, on July 7, 1997, to be taken from the Calamity Fund under the Annual Budget of 1997.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Social Services Development Department (SSDD) shall validate and authenticate the list of fire victims categorized into family owner, family sharer and family renter and to submit the same to the Office of the City Mayor, for the purpose of giving the necessary relief operations.
